Write to **your** MP

What?

We are asking MPs for a young people's constituency surgery (where they meet with young people from their area). We want to talk to them about the issues that matter to us - they need to hear what children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) care about most!

When?

We want to meet with MPs across the country on Friday 15th November.

How?

Writing to your MP is as easy as 1, 2, 3...

1) Find your local MP.

Look on parliament's website, and search your postcode.

2) Write your message.

Introduce yourself, and why your contacting them. Include a call to action - to meet with you on the 15th November.

3) Send.

Why?

Each local area is different - you know what works, and what doesn't.

Our voice is important and MPs need to hear what we have to say. You can help with that!

We have also launched an MPs toolkit to help them understand SEND and how they can help you!
